ARTS ONLY/3D ART (K-6 @ 10:00) Class limit: 15

Kids will learn many fundamentals of art exploring the areas of drawing, painting and crafts.

BABYSITTING (5-6 @ 10:00) Class limit: 15

This class is designed to provide beginning babysitters with advice and tips for caring for kids of all ages.

BUILDING WITH LEGOS (K-6 @ 9:00, 11:00) Class limit: 10

Students will use their imagination by constructing and designing various Lego creations based on the weeks theme.

COMPUTER GAMES (K-6 @ 9:00, 10:00) Class limit: 15

Students will get familiar with the computer by playing a variety of fun and educational games in the computer lab. Limit 2 hours
